SCHOOL SELECTION - MARCH 2012

- IT Department: random selection of 50 % of schools
- 35 elementary and 8 secondary
- Memos went out from the Superintendent of Program with copies of the tools attached
- All TLs in the system were invited to complete the surveys

ELEMENTARY DATA ANALYSIS -MAY 2012 - STRENGTHS

- Elementary libraries are in good condition and are visually inviting.
- Library collections are in good condition.
- Libraries are accessible to staff and students during the school day.
- Most staff and students have access to resources.
- Most students have the opportunity to take home resources.
- Many library programs support school literacy initiatives.
- Many TL's collaborate with teachers to plan and support learning and reading initiatives within their schools.

SECONDARY DATA ANALYSIS - MAY 2012 - STRENGTHS

- Library Commons collections are in good condition
- Libraries are accessible to staff and students during the school day.
- All staff and students have access to resources.
- All students have the opportunity to take home resources.
- Many principals approve purchases for the library on a request basis.
- New resources are evident in every library.
- All TL's have librarianship qualifications or equivalents.
- Most TL's have been in the position two or more years.
- Many TL's collaborate with classroom teachers to develop lessons and work with groups of students

ELEMENTARY GAPS


- Support of Learning Goals and Success Criteria in elementary libraries- some evidence shown. A focus on A&E is needed.
- More emphasis and focus on the development of 21st century learning skills.
- Improved student awareness, use, and availability of technology: assistive, virtual presence, Destiny, etc.
- Role of library commons not articulated in school improvement plans

SECONDARY GAPS

- Support of Learning Goals and Success Criteria, literacy, numeracy and pathway initiatives- little evidence shown. A focus on A&E is needed.
- More emphasis and focus on the development of 21st century learning skills.
- Improved student and staff awareness, use, and availability of technology-assistive, virtual presence, Destiny, etc. Only one TL is the CIESC for their school.

SUGGESTED ACTION ITEMS

- Development of a useful web presence
- Articulation of role of school learning commons program in the school improvement plan
- A&E
- For elementary, as TLS are prep providers, an emphasis on inquiry-based learning, rather than book exchange and
- For secondary, increased collaboration with classroom teachers, especially on technology integration, inquiry-learning (critical thinking, problem solving, info literacy)








TL TRAINING PORTAL USERS - MAY AND JUNE 2012



WHAT THIS DATA TELLS US... ELEMENTARY

Improvements:

- schools posting LG and SC in library commons
- Focus on 21st century skills
- New purchases of books
- Book exchanges outside of LC time
- Virtual presence

Gaps:

- TLs not seeing all students
- Library Commons in school improvement plans
- Designated access to Destiny
- Flexible spaces

WHAT THIS DATA TELLS US... SECONDARY

Improvements:

- LC's role in school improvement plans
- Reading promotion
- Flexible spaces in physical commons
 Gaps:
- Learning goals and success criteria
- Evidence of student learning
- Teaching of 21st century skills
- Collaborative partnerships
- Use of databases

WHAT THE STUDENTS TOLD US...

Successes:

- Using technology
- How to search the internet
- How to determine reliable information
- How to use a variety of sources
- How to ask good questions


Gaps:
