

To open a book is to open your mind." - Amberle Cianne Literacy - Circulation In the 2023-24 school year, 9526 books were borrowed. This was an increase from 8126 in 2022-23 (17.2%) and 4368 in 2021-22 (118%). The love of reading has a direct correlation to higher literacy scores in standardized tests. Relationships -**Reading Conversations** In 2024, the teacher-librarian conducted 264 Forest of Reading chats with students, compared to 239 in 2023 (10.5% increase) and 105 in 2022 (151.42% increase) **Student Agency** - Recess Visits There were 1385 recess library visits in 2023-2024, up by 9.92% from the previous
