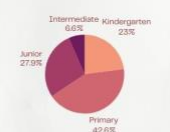
### COLLABORATION

14 collaborative units were planned/taught with the TL in the 2021-22 school year involving 11/13 classes from Pre-K to Grade 8!



### BUDGET

Despite a lower-than-anticipated budget due to declining enrolment (\$3210 vs \$4080), we did not overspend and were still able to add 420 books to the collection as of April 30, 2022.



**Summer Library Loans**  
 A total of 61 students and 423 books participated in the "Baker's Dozen Borrowing Bonanza"



**Circulation bounced back after the pandemic**  
 A total of 4368 books were borrowed over the 2021-22 school year

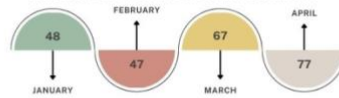

### STUDENT LITERACY ENGAGEMENT

In 2023, the teacher-librarian conducted 239 Forest of Reading chats, compared to 105 in 2022, 166 in 2020, and 202 in 2019.



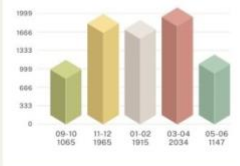
### COLLABORATION

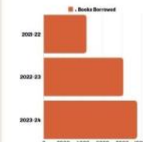

## LIBRARY REPORT

### Literacy - Circulation



In the 2023-24 school year, 9526 books were borrowed. This was an increase from 8126 in 2022-23 (17.2%) and 4368 in 2021-22 (118%). The love of reading has a direct correlation to higher literacy scores in standardized tests.

### Relationships - Reading Conversations

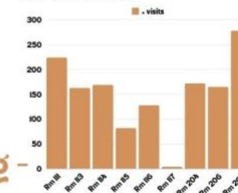
In 2024, the teacher-librarian conducted 264 Forest of Reading chats with students, compared to 239 in 2023 (10.5% increase) and 105 in 2022 (151.42% increase)



### Student Agency - Recess Visits

There were 1385 recess library visits in 2023-2024, up by 9.92% from the previous year's total of 1260 visits. 14.2% came at recess to finish work and 10.1% came to borrow books.

The greatest number of users of the Library Learning Commons at recess came from the Grade 8 class (Room 207, 20%) followed by the Grade 4-5 class (Room III, 16%)



### Joy & Belonging - Clubs

The teacher librarian ran 9 clubs in the 2023-2024 school year, including Library Helpers, Robotics and Rubik's Cube. This aligned with the Specialist Teacher PCC goal of supporting students with anxiety.
